Each luminaria candle is \$5.

"Each luminaria represents the life of someone who has battled cancer. It is a beautiful sight when all the bags with candles are illuminated around the track," said Kathy Buwalda, volunteer luminaria chair. "The Luminaria Ceremony is a moving way to remember loved ones lost to cancer and to pay tribute to cancer survivors."

This year there will be luminaria for the Caregiver and those bags will be purple, with a lit candle and will also cost \$5. They will circle the track with the white bags. This is a way to honor that caregiver who took care of the person with cancer.
