Hunter's Point Hunt Club, owned by Todd Cardinal, located two miles west of Hwy. 151 and Byron on CTH F, is open to the public on Fridays for lunch and dinner fish frys during the summer. Enjoy a fish entrée and a great view over their hunting grounds or a drink by the campfire as the sun sets. The kitchen is staffed by chef Shelly Schultz, who has been with the establishment for three years. Shelly makes a salmon that can turn the head of even the harshest salmon-critic. The dining area is run/managed by the skilled hands of Manager Beth Vaghn, as well as waitresses Nichole Nolan and Steph Kramer.
